

PSSI'S NATO SUMMER SCHOOL THE EVOLVING DYNAMICS OF THE RUSSIAN AND CHINESE THREATS JULY 3—8, 2022, ORLÍK, CZECH REPUBLIC

Advance your career prospects this summer with our prestigious NATO Summer School, organized in cooperation with NATO's Public Diplomacy Division and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Czech Republic.

This intensive one-week course brings together a select group of graduate students and young professionals seeking to deepen their expertise with regard to the current threat environment and available policy options.

The course includes 15 lectures by Czech and foreign security experts, including sitting and former senior policy practitioners and scholars. Additionally, participants take part in a week-long international crisis simulation based on actual geopolitical circumstances.
